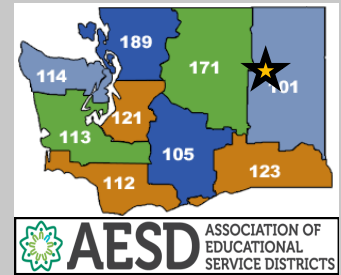

OUR MISSION: NEWESD 101 is a public entity created by the state of Washington to serve public school districts, charter and state-approved private schools in grades PK-12. It is one of nine ESDs in a statewide network.



NEWESD 101 SERVICES: Services are offered in nearly 75 specialty areas including: business management, behavioral health, early childhood education, school nutrition, youth violence prevention, educational technology, fingerprinting, grants management, industrial hygiene, pupil transportation, school safety, substance abuse prevention programs, professional learning, school financial, school nursing, special education, STEM (science, technology, engineering & math), student records, youth training and employment and workers' compensation.

Schools and districts select the services they need based on local need. NEWESD 101 services supplement those available locally.
