

Funding Guidelines

The Northeast Washington Education Council (NEWEC) will be a vehicle to enhance the ability of NorthEast Washington Educational Service District (NEWESD) 101 to meet the needs of P-12 school districts, students and other regional learning communities. Council priorities will be placed on NEWESD 101 initiatives that:

- a) Fund programs and services that directly impact students.
- b) Fund programs and services for students such as at-risk, gifted or Career & Technical Education.
- c) Promote partnerships between business and education that directly benefit students.
- d) Promote scholarships by administering scholarship funds.

NEWEC Funding Guidelines:

- 1. Requests will be pre-screened, evaluated and prioritized by the NEWESD Administrative Cabinet. Only projects deemed the most needed or worthy will be forwarded to the NEWEC Board with recommendations for funding.
- 2. The same application form will be used for internal and external requests.
- 3. There will be no limit on the dollar amount of requests for either internal or external applications. The requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. There will be no limit on the frequency of requests by one party. The requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Each request will require a simple majority vote by the NEWEC Board to approve or reject.
- 6. Applications will be considered four times per year. Applications are due to NEWESD 101 one month prior to the next scheduled NEWEC board meeting, typically scheduled in January, April, June and October.
- 7. NEWESD 101 will inform NEWEC of grant applications that have been denied, and NEWEC will send a letter to the applicant.
- 8. The Board will inform all applicants within 10 days of the Board decision if their request has been awarded or denied. The NEWEC Board Chair or designee will inform each applicant.
